

Open a Book, Find a Treasure, READ!

As summer vacation is about to begin, please consider the importance of including time for reading in your summer plans.

Why is summer reading important? Research demonstrates that on average, children experience up to 4 weeks of learning loss over the summer! Children who struggle with reading can lose up to 12 weeks of reading progress. How can we prevent this loss? Read every day! We know that studies show the more students read, the better their comprehension, vocabulary, and fluency will be.

What is the goal? To participate, your child needs to read (or be read to \odot) 1,000 minutes (that is 50 twenty-minute sessions) between June 11th and August 29th. Every time your child completes 20 minutes of reading, he/she should color one gem (on the back of this page). Return this reading log with a parent/guardian signature to your child's 2021-22 teacher by Thursday, September 2nd.

What reading activities count toward the 20 minutes? All reading counts toward the 1,000 minute goal. Please include participation in the Lebanon Community Library's summer reading program and minutes completing reading activities on websites, such as Reading Eggs and Study Island. ALL reading counts—reading by yourself, reading to someone (even a pet!), and having someone else read to you! ©
